

Our time there will include a tour of the Vatican Museum, a papal audience, and Mass in front of the original icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help. We also will spend a day visiting Assisi, a site made special by two other famous saints, Francis and Clare.

Please join me and your fellow pilgrims as we travel the beautiful countryside, retrace the steps of Sts. Gerard and Alphonsus, and explore the Eternal City of Rome. As we celebrate the 280th birthday of the Redemptorists in 2012, I hope you will come with us as we give thanks and renew our mission to share God's message of plentiful redemption with the world.

## "In the Footsteps of Sts. Gerard Majella and Alphonsus Liguori" ITINERARY

### Day 1 Tuesday, October 9: Depart U.S.A.

Today, depart Washington Dulles International Airport via United Airlines on your non-stop flight to Rome, Italy.

Complimentary meals and beverages will be served aloft. (D)

### Day 2 Wednesday, October 10: Arrive in Rome – Marianella - Naples



Upon arrival at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim your luggage and your group will be greeted and assisted by a Passages by Peter's Way tour manager as we exit customs. Board our private motor coach, and we will be on our way to Naples, situated on a beautiful bay along the Mediterranean Coast. Enjoy your panoramic ride of the city, including Mergellina, Castel dell'Ovo, Plebiscito Square, The Royal Palace, and the Maschio Angioino with its triumphal arch and deep moats. Enjoy (with opportunities to photograph) the famous view of the city, the bay and Mt. Vesuvius. Independent lunch. Then, we continue to the nearby town of Marianella to visit the home of St. Alphonsus. St. Alphonsus Maria de Liguori (September 27, 1696 – August 1, 1787) was an Italian Catholic bishop, spiritual writer, moral theologian, founder of the Redemptorists, and is a Doctor of the Church. He was canonized in 1839 by Pope Gregory XVI. **Celebrate Mass.** Check-in at hotel in Naples.



### Day 3 Thursday, October 11: Pompeii – Amalfi Drive - Salerno

Buffet breakfast at your hotel. Begin our day with a visit to Pompeii, and explore the incredibly well-preserved remains of this ancient Roman town, where all life was suddenly stopped by an eruption of Vesuvius in the year 79 A.D. The volcano buried Pompeii under 60 feet of ash and pumice, and it was lost for nearly 1,700 years before its accidental rediscovery in 1748. Pompeii provides an extraordinarily detailed insight into the life of a city at the height of the Roman Empire and is one of the most popular tourist attractions of Italy. **Celebrate Mass at the Franciscan Basilica of the Rosary in Pompeii.** Independent lunch. After lunch, we leave Pompeii and take a spectacular drive along the Amalfi coast. We will enjoy

a remarkable bird's-eye view of Positano, which commands a beautiful view of the Gulf of Naples. Stops include the towns of Amalfi, Minori, Ravello, Vietri Sul Mare and we end our day in Salerno.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Salerno. (B,D)

### Day 4 Friday, October 12: Excursion to visit Scala

Buffet breakfast at your hotel. Today we depart for Scala which is located on a rocky hill on the Amalfi Coast. Upon arrival we visit the 12th-century Cathedral of St. Lorenzo. Visit the convent that first welcomed St. Alphonsus and the five founding fathers of the Redemptorists. We'll also see the Cave of the Revelations, St. Alphonsus' favorite place of meditation and prayer. Other sites include the Casa Anastasio, the Convent of the Redemptoristine Nuns, and the house of the Redemptorists. Independent lunch. **Celebrate Mass in Scala** before we return to Salerno. Balance of the day at leisure. (B,D)

### Day 5 Saturday, October 13: Excursion to visit the Towns of Pagani, Ciorani and Materdomini



Buffet breakfast at your hotel. Today we depart Salerno to visit the town of Pagani, the Basilica of St. Alphonsus, which houses the saint's tomb, and the Redemptorist house. Visit the Alphonsian Museum and the picture gallery. The Museum was inaugurated in 1990 by Blessed Pope John Paul II, and houses items associated with St. Alphonsus, including the harpsichord on which he composed the famous Italian Christmas hymn, "Tu Scendi Dalle Stelle." Independent lunch.

Proceed to the town of Ciorani to visit the original Motherhouse of the Redemptorists. Continue on to the town of Materdomini to visit the hamlet that takes its name from a 16th-century church dedicated to the Mother of God, and where St. Alphonsus opened one of the first Redemptorist houses. It was also here in 1755 that St. Gerard Majella died. **Celebrate Mass in the Basilica dedicated to St. Gerard Majella.** Dinner and overnight at hotel in Salerno. (B,D)

### Day 6 Sunday, October 14: Montecassino - Rome

Buffet breakfast at your hotel. This morning, we leave Salerno for Rome. En-route, we visit the Benedictine Monastery of Montecassino. St. Benedict founded his religious family here in the 5th century. **Attend the 11 a.m.**

**Sunday Mass with the monks of the Abbey.**

Independent lunch. This afternoon we continue to the "Eternal City." During our stay, we'll take in the rich history of the city that spans more than 2,500 years, and enjoy the beauty and holiness at the heart of the Church. On to your hotel for check-in. Independent dinner.

Overnight at hotel in Rome.

**Day 7 Monday, October 15: AM/Tour of the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel & St. Peter's Basilica – PM/At Leisure**

After early breakfast, **celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter** (to be confirmed) or one of the Grottos in the Basilica of St. Peter. After Mass, we begin our morning of sightseeing with a visit to one of the great art collections in the world, the Vatican Museums. Walk in the footsteps of the Princes of the Church through the richly decorated galleries. Continue on to the Sistine Chapel, the private chapel of the popes, where Michelangelo best expressed his genius in monumental frescoes. End your morning tour in St. Peter's Basilica. Take in the awesome architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the new tomb of Blessed John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. On your own, with time permitting, you may wish to go to the Vatican Crypt to see and pray near the tomb of St. Peter and where numerous pontiffs are buried.

Independent lunch and afternoon at leisure.

This afternoon is your opportunity to explore the sights, sounds and tastes of Rome all on your own! Perhaps you will want to buy religious articles in preparation for the Papal Blessing at the audience on Wednesday. Or you may want to treat yourself to a leisurely multi-course lunch in a quaint trattoria. There are always plenty of churches, museums, piazzas and ancient ruins to explore. This is the time to hit high fashion spots, as well as the local shops and street vendors. Rome is yours! Independent dinner.

Overnight at hotel in Rome.

**Day 8 Tuesday, October 16: Assisi - Visit Sites of St. Francis & St. Clare**

After breakfast, leave Rome on our comfortable motor coach for Assisi, one of the high points of any travel experience to Italy. The narrow lanes, the Shrine of St. Francis, and the overwhelming art dedicated to this simple friar — a rich young man who turned to God after an illness and established an order known for its passionate love for God revealed in creation and in humanity. Upon arrival, **celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Francis.** After Mass, our local guide will take us to explore the Basilica complex, which is actually composed of two churches built one atop the other. Visit the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower Basilica dates from 1228-30, and is richly decorated with beautiful stained glass windows, and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper Basilica, built between 1230-53, you will marvel at the monumental frescoes painted by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of Francis. Continue to visit the Basilica of St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement, view her remains and see the miraculous San Damiano Crucifix. Group lunch in Assisi. This afternoon, we leave Assisi to visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, a great basilica built in 1569 and crowned by the magnificent dome designed by Alessi. It encloses the shrine of the Porziuncula, or the "Little Portion" Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered, the place where Clare received the habit from Francis, and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where St. Francis died. You will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. Independent dinner.

**Day 9 Wednesday, October 17: AM/Papal Audience – PM/Tour of Christian Rome**

After a leisurely breakfast, **our group will participate in the regular Wednesday general audience with our Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI.** Our pilgrimage will be acknowledged during the English language portion.

Independent lunch. This afternoon, visit the magnificent Basilica of St. Paul, built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. Surrounding the nave are the medallions of each Pope, from Peter to Benedict XVI. Continue to the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. It was founded by the Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and was home to the popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. Continue our tour with a visit the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major Basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (AD 432-440). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics in the nave depicting scenes from the Old Testament. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. Continue to the Church of St. Alphonsus Liguori, dedicated to the Redemptorist founder and headquarters of the worldwide Congregation. This church is also the home of the original icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help, which has been in Rome since 1499. In 1866, Pope Pius IX gave the miraculous icon to the care of the Redemptorists and commissioned them to "make her known." Due to the Redemptorists' missionary efforts, this image of the Blessed Virgin Mary is one of the most recognizable in the world. **End our day with a Mass at the Church of St. Alphonsus All'Esquilino.**

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Rome.

## Your pilgrimage includes:

- Round-trip economy class transportation via United Airlines: Dulles/Rome/Dulles.
- U.S. departure tax; Customs user fee; security tax and all airport departure taxes.
- Meeting and assistance upon departure from Dulles International Airport.
- Eight (8) nights' accommodations in twin-bedded rooms with private facilities in first class hotels throughout.
- European buffet breakfast daily plus one (1) lunch in Assisi, and six (6) dinners.
- Services of a Passages by Peter's Way tour manager upon arrival in Naples to departure in Rome.
- All sightseeing, as per the itinerary, in a private, deluxe, air-conditioned motor coach.
- Services of a professional, licensed, English-speaking guide.
- Entrance fees to all sites, as per attached itinerary.
- Coordination of all Liturgies as per attached itinerary.
- Portage of one piece of luggage per person at hotels throughout the tour.
- Portfolio of travel documents, for each participant, including a Passages by Peter's Way flight packet.

## Items not included in the package price:

**PAYMENT:** Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check or money order only. In an effort to keep prices as low as possible, the package price reflects a cash discount. However, it is possible to make your final payment via MasterCard, Visa, Discover, or American Express. A \$100.00 convenience fee will apply to all packages paid by credit card. Invoices and credit card authorization forms will be included with your welcome document. The credit card form must be completed in entirety in order for the transaction to be approved. Passages by Peter's Way reserves the right to increase package rate or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. dollar in excess of 10% from print date. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will be required.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** Round trip from Washington-Dulles via United Airlines. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Airfare is subject to increases prior to date of travel. By sending your deposit together with your completed reservation form before the deposit deadline, airfare will be guaranteed against future fare increases excluding tax increases or fuel surcharges. Tax and fuel surcharge estimation is based on increases imposed by airlines is subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). (see LATE RESERVATIONS) Airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can be made at time of check-in only. If you are a member of the frequent flyer or affiliate program, please bring your account card to the airport on the day of departure to receive proper mileage credit. Passages by Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences or frequent flyer information as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored.

**ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS:** Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Triple rooms are available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double-bedded rooms with a cot or rollaway bed added. **Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of \$595.00.** While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin rooms and are sometimes located away from the group in a different area of the hotel, and may be in high traffic areas, such as stairways/elevators. We honestly do not like to assess an additional charge for the single traveler and will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancelling, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

**MEALS:** European buffet breakfast plus (1) lunch in Assisi, and seven (7) dinners, including a farewell dinner with wine and entertainment at Azienda Agricola Il Castellaccio. Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

**SIGHTSEEING AND ENTRANCE FEES:** All sightseeing as per itinerary aboard a private motorcoach with the services of a professional, licensed, English-speaking guide. Entrance fees to all sights are included.

**LAND ONLY PASSENGERS:** A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (\$2,495.00 per person, sharing a twin room) must notify Passages by Peter's Way, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. *Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the land only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group,*

*you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Passages by Peter's Way will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.*

**BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:** Due to bus space, one carry-on bag and one checked bag per person are permitted. **SERVICE CHARGES:** All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave Euro 1.00 per person for the waiters after each meal; Euro 1.00 per person per day for the maid/bell boys.

**TIPPING:** For good work, recommended (but voluntary) tipping to your tour manager is Euro 4.00 per passenger per day; to the driver is Euro 2.00 per passenger per day; for the local guides Euro 1.50 per passenger per day. Tips for the tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually.

**TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY:** All passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others as Pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, climbing up/down stairs, etc. Any passenger who is physically challenged must submit a certificate from his/her medical doctor stating that he/she is capable of taking part in this pilgrimage without assistance. If special assistance is required, the passenger must travel with a companion willing and capable of providing any necessary assistance.

**TRAVEL INSURANCE:** It is strongly recommended that all participants buy insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for lost or damaged luggage or trip interruption. Passages by Peter's Way offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan. These benefits and services help insure the well being of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The plan payments are based on total package price, including single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc. The plan payment for total package prices from \$0 to \$2,100.00 is \$139; \$2,101.00 to \$3,000.00 is \$175.00; from \$3,001.00 and over is \$199.00. **If the plan payment is made at the time of deposit or within 10 days of receiving the Passages by Peter's Way "Tour Deposit Acknowledgment Letter," the passenger will be covered for pre-existing conditions.
